DIRECTIONS

From I-65 South: Take Exit 134 onto Arthur Street. Go down Arthur Street to Cardinal Blvd. Turn right on Cardinal Blvd. Turn left on Third Street. The Law School will be on the left, immediately after the Speed Art Museum.

From I-65 North: Take Exit 133B (Eastern Parkway). Turn left onto Warnock Avenue from the exit light. Turn right on Floyd Street. Turn left on Cardinal Blvd. and then left on Third Street. The Law School will be on the left immediately after the Speed Art Museum.

Parking: After reaching the Speed Art Museum, turn left into the oval and parking will be available in the lot on the left hand side at the end of the oval, next to Grawemeyer Hall. The Law School is on the far north side of the oval. There is also parking available for a charge in a parking garage located near the Speed Art Museum.
