INDICTMENT AND INFORMATION

RCr 6.52 Warrant or summons upon indictment or information; issuance

Upon the request of the attorney for the Commonwealth the court shall direct the clerk to issue a warrant for each defendant named in the indictment or information. The clerk shall issue a summons instead of a warrant upon the request of the attorney for the Commonwealth or on direction of the court. Upon request of the attorney for the Commonwealth, the clerk shall issue more than one warrant or summons for the same defendant. The clerk shall deliver the warrant or summons to a peace officer for execution or service. If a defendant fails to appear in response to the summons, a warrant shall issue.
